SEAMASS 2026 Structural Engineering Student Scholarship

SEAMASS is pleased to announce that we will award up to two scholarships of \$2,000 each in May 2026 to one or two candidates who are college students (at ABET accredited universities) with a focus on Structural Engineering.

This scholarship opportunity is open to all undergraduate and graduate students in Civil or Architectural Engineering programs. Applicants must either be studying at a MA University or a resident of Massachusetts.

Candidates shall provide a brief essay of 500 to 750 words in response to these questions:

1. What inspired you to study Structural Engineering?
2. How do you see yourself contributing to the Structural Engineering field following graduation?

The SEAMASS Scholarship Committee shall review all essay submissions.

Application Submission Deadline: March 31, 2026 by 8:00 p.m. ET.

SEAMASS Scholarship Awards will be announced in early May, and the winner(s) will be invited to the 2026 SEAMASS Annual Meeting and dinner on May 19, 2026.
